#### What are Nutriwound capsules?

# How does Nutriwound capsules works?

Wound healing is a complex and dynamic process of replacing devitalized and missing cellular structures and tissue layers. Components of Nutriwound supports the different stages of healing.

Vitamin C is involved in all phases of wound healing. Vitamin C is essential to counteract the production of free radicals in damaged cells.

The herb Hintonia latiflora in Nutriwound act as key ingredient for supporting blood sugar health and thus accelerating the process of healing. Chromium picolinate is also essential for healthy insulin function.

Vitamin A stimulates epidermal turnover, increases the rate of re-epithelialization, and restores epithelial structure of skin. It has the unique ability to reverse the inhibitory effects of anti-inflammatory steroids on wound healing.

Zinc plays a major role in regulating every phase of the wound healing process, ranging from membrane repair, oxidative stress, coagulation, inflammation and immune defence, tissue re-epithelialization, angiogenesis, to fibrosis/scar formation. Copper is added in formulation to overcome copper deficiency which may be as result of zinc.

Supportive B vitamins in Nutriwound are essential cofactors in enzyme reactions involved in leukocyte formation and in anabolic processes of wound healing. They are also required for the synthesis of collagen.

Vitamin D can affect wound healing by increasing the production of epidermal and platelet growth factors.

Selenium act as antioxidant and thus protecting the cells from free radicals.

#### Who should take Nutriwound capsules?

# What does wound and wound healing means?

A skin wound results from the breakdown of the epidermal layer (outermost layer of skin) integrity. Wound healing mostly means healing of the skin. This process is divided into predictable phases; blood clotting (haemostasis), inflammation, tissue growth (cell proliferation), and tissue remodelling (maturation and cell differentiation). The wound healing process is not only complex but fragile, and it is susceptible to interruption or failure leading to the formation of non-healing chronic wounds. Factors that contribute to non-healing chronic wounds are diabetes, venous or arterial disease, infection, and metabolic deficiencies

#### What are the precautions to be taken while using Nutriwound capsules?
